

Jenkins Family Endowment

The Jenkins Family Endowment was established in 2014 to honor the memory of Creties D. Jenkins, Sr., Marian R. Jenkins, and James M. Jenkins, Sr.

Creties and Marian were married in 1945 and raised five sons on the family farm, which was originally located in Liverpool Township (Grafton Road) and then later in York Township (Station Road).

The boys all graduated from Buckeye High School (Ed '64, David '67, Tom '69, Creties Jr. '76, Jim '77) with Jim specializing in the mechanical trades at the Joint Vocational School.

After graduation, Jim formed a partnership (CMJ Farms) with mom and dad, raising cattle and crops for almost 35 years. When they passed away in 2011, Jim continued running the farm, as well as his own mechanics business, but sadly succumbed to cancer in 2014.

Their spirit of hard work, dedication to the task-at-hand, and practical innovation inspired this endowment. It is hoped that teachers and students alike will embody these characteristics as they put the money to good use.
